Melbourne Convention + Visitors Bureau - Officially Australia's Best

Melbourne Convention + Visitors Bureau (MCVB) has been recognised as Australia's best, taking out the 'Metropolitan Convention Bureau/Tourist Organisation' Award at the prestigious national Meetings & Events Australia (MEA) Industry Awards.

The award was one of two for MCVB at the National MEA Awards, at which MCVB, with event manager Reed Exhibitions, was also awarded 'Exhibition of the Year' for AIME 2008.

MCVB was judged on a host of criteria, including: business planning; resource management; creating opportunities, and; contribution to the industry.

In support of its award submission, MCVB reported a record year of achievement, attracting more than 70,000 delegates to Victoria, injecting more than \$261million into the State economy.

Speaking on the win, Ms Sandra Chipchase, MCVB's CEO, said the award comes at an exciting time for both Melbourne and MCVB.

'Despite increasing competition globally, Melbourne continues to see growth in the Business Events sector because of its infrastructure, superior facilities and services, outstanding Government investment and support, and of course our reputation for being the most stylish and sophisticated city in Australia.
